Thank you for your request which I received on 22 April. You asked for information regarding the previous Interreg IIIa programme, specifically:

- The final report of the Interreg IIIa project entitled SMART

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government. The Welsh Government is only required to keep documentation for three years after the final payment to or from the European Commission for each Programme therefore documentation for programmes for 2000-2006 programmes have passed their data retention period and are therefore no longer available.

Project partners are responsible for reports, therefore I would suggest contacting University College Dublin in relation to your enquiry.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
