ATISN 15124: Request for information

Thank you for your request which I received on 11 May 2021. You asked for information on Small Holding number 55/60/0148 as follows:

- When the property was first registered as a Small Holding and the names it has been registered under;
- Any maps showing the curtilage of the property and site of any surface water drains or storm drains;
- Any planning applications for drainage;
- Any grants provided for the Small Holding; and
- Any agreements made under the Town and County Planning act for s106 agreements between the landowners and the relevant governing bodies.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

The holding number you quote does not exist on the Welsh Government's CPH register. It is possibly a number from an old system that was closed some time ago as it was not in use.

The holding has been on our records since we set up our current system in 2000. A change of the record was made to include your name in 2016.

There is no record of any scheme payments or grants in relation to this address and as such no details are held on our mapping system.
