Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 10 June. You requested information related to Covid 19 evidence used by Welsh Government specifically:

- 1. To provide the evidence that the Welsh Government is using to show that congregational singing, chanting, or shouting whilst individuals or households are socially distanced, wearing face coverings, and building ventilation is enhanced, increases the risk of transmission of Covid 19.*
