ROAD TRAFFIC

THE TRUNK ROAD (A470) (RHAYADER, POWYS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1993

MADE

28th June 1993

COMING INTO FORCE 8th July

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the power conferred upon him by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and 124(1) of and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Police hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into force on **8th** July 1993 and may be cited as The Trunk Road (A470) (Rhayader, Powys) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 199.
- 2. (1) In this Order:-

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and

- (2) For the purpose, of this Order a vehicle displays:
- (i) a disabled person's badge issued before 2 March 1992 in the relevant position, if:
 - a. in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - b. in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.
- (ii) a disabled person's badge issued on or after 2 March 1992 in the relevant position if:
 - a. in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or

- b. in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; and
- (iii) a parking disc is in the relevant position:
 - a. in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - b. in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in article 5, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths or on the sides of the road specified in Schedule 1.
- 4. Save as provided in article 5, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 08.00 and 18.00 hours on any day on the side of the road specified in Schedule 2.
- 4. (1) Nothing in articles 3 or 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths or on the sides of the road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - a. a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - b. goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - c. the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths or sides of the road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or in land adjacent to the said lengths or sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 (a);



- d. the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- e. the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths or sides of the road;
- f. the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- g. the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packages as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953(a)
- (2) Nothing in articles 3 or 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths or on the sides of the road referred to therein for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road on the same day).
- 5. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment including the Act of 1984 and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment including the Act of 1984.
- 6. The Trunk Road (A470) (Rhayader, Powys) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1990(b) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULES

The lengths and sides of the trunk road referred to in these Schedules are at Rhayader in the County of Powys.

SCHEDULE 1 - NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

- 1. That length of the trunk road known as South Street which extends from a point 27.4 metres south-east of its junction with Cae Herbert Lane to its junction with West Street/East Street.
- 2. The south-west side of that length of the trunk road known as North Street, which extends from its junction with West Street, B4518, to a point 27.4 metres north-west of that junction.
- 3. The north-east side of that length of the trunk road known as North Street, which extends from its junction with East Street, A44, to a point 20.4 metres, south east of its junction with Cross Lane.
- 4. That length of the trunk road, known in part as North Street, in part as New Road, and in part as Llangurig Road which extends from a point 20.4 metres south east of its junction with Cross Lane to a point 82.1 metres north west of its junction with Tanners Row.

SCHEDULE 2 - NO WAITING BETWEEN 08.00 AND 18.00 HOURS

The south-west side of that length of the trunk road known as North Street which extends from a point 27.4 metres north-west of its junction with West Street, B4518, to a point 20.4 metres south-east of its junction with Cross Lane.
