

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A483
(FFORDD OSGOI'R TRALLWNG, POWYS)
(GWAHARDD CERBYDAU DROS DRO) 2021**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar Ffordd Osgoi'r Trallwng yr A483, neu gerllaw iddi.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd pob cerbyd (ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys neu ar gyfer y gwaith) rhag mynd ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A483 sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd ag ochr ogleddol Cylchfan The Old Station hyd at gyffordd Flash, y Trallwng.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer traffig sy'n teithio tua'r gogledd yw mynd ar Mill Lane tua'r dwyrain, ar Church Bank yr A458 tua'r gogledd ac ar Salop Road yr A458 tua'r gogledd-ddwyrain. Dylai traffig sy'n teithio tua'r de ddilyn Salop Road yr A458 tua'r de-orllewin ac yna Mill Lane tua'r de-ddwyrain.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 10 Gorffennaf 2021 a disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol o 20:00 o'r gloch ar y dyddiad hwnnw hyd 06:00 o'r gloch ar 11 Gorffennaf 2021 neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad ymlaen llaw am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (WELSHPOOL
BYPASS, POWYS) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 2021**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A483 Welshpool Bypass, Powys.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit all vehicles (other than those being used by the emergency services or for the works) from proceeding on the length of the A483 trunk road that extends from its junction with the northern side of the Old Station Roundabout to The Flash junction, Welshpool.

The alternative route for northbound traffic is via the eastbound Mill Lane, northbound A458 Church Bank and north-eastbound A458 Salop Road. Southbound traffic should follow the south-westbound A458 Salop Road and south-eastbound Mill Lane.

The Order comes into force on 10 July 2021 and the temporary prohibition is expected to operate from 20:00 hours on that date until 06:00 hours on 11 July 2021 or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the period specified above, it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Advance notice of changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work.
