GORCHYMYN CAU PRIFFYRDD (TIR YN HEOL Y CAPEL, CAERFYRDDIN, SIR GAERFYRDDIN) 2021

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 247 o Ddeddf Cynllunio Gwlad a Thref 1990 ("y Ddeddf") i awdurdodi cau'r darn o briffordd a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Hysbysiad hwn. Nid awdurdodir cau'r briffordd ond er mwyn gwneud y datblygiad a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Hysbysiad hwn yn unol â'r caniatâd cynllunio a roddwyd o dan Ran 3 o'r Ddeddf gan Gyngor Sir Caerfyrddin ar 9 Chwefror 2017 o dan y cyfeirnod W/34922.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (LAND AT CHAPEL STREET, CARMARTHEN, CARMARTHESHIRE) ORDER 2021

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") to authorise the stopping up of the length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Notice. The stopping up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this Notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part 3 of the Act by Carmarthenshire County Council on 9 February 2017 with reference number W/34922.

The Stopping Up of Highways (Land at Chapel Street, Carmarthen, Carmarthenshire) Order 2021 ("the Order") ceases to have effect if planning permission in respect of the development expires or is revoked.

Copies of the Order and the deposited plan may be inspected free of charge at Carmarthen Library, St Peter's Street, Carmarthen, SA31 1LN, can be viewed on the Welsh Government's website at <https://gov.wales/stopping-orders> or may be obtained free of charge from the address below quoting reference qA1418885.

If a person is aggrieved by the Order, on the grounds that:

- a. it is not within the powers of the Act; or
- b. a procedural requirement of the Act has not been complied with;

that person may, within 6 weeks of 28 July 2021 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Y datblygiad

Adeiladu 3 uned gyfagos ar ffurf ciosg i'w defnyddio ar gyfer manwerthu ar dir cyhoeddus presennol i gerddwyr yn Heol y Capel, Caerfyrddin. Mae hyn yn rhan o brosiect adfywio ehangach i ddatblygu Sgwâr Jackson yn ganolfan ddiwylliannol a busnes yn yr hen dref, Caerfyrddin.

SCHEDULE 1
(All measurements are approximate)
Length of highway to be stopped up

An irregular shaped length of highway located on the northern side of the south-western end of Chapel Street, Carmarthen with a maximum length of 13.7 metres and a maximum width of 4 metres shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan.

SCHEDULE 2
The development

The construction of 3 adjoining kiosk-style units for retail use on existing pedestrian public realm at Chapel Street, Carmarthen. This forms part of a wider regeneration project to develop Jackson's Square as a cultural and business hub within the old quarter of Carmarthen.
