ATISN 15443 Environmental Impact Assessments

Thank you for your request which I received on 18 August 2021. You asked for:

- The following information relating to final decisions on Environmental Impact Assessments (EIAs), from both Ministers and Local Planning Authorities, for livestock and aquaculture developments from 2010 to present.
 - date of submission;
 - species of animal to be reared;
 - address of development;
 - name of company or individual who would own the development;
 - the local planning authority; and
 - outcome of decision.
- Following information relating to all livestock and aquaculture developments for which an environmental statement has been submitted either to Ministers or to a local planning authority, but no final decision has yet been made.
 - date of submission;
 - species of animal to be reared;
 - address of development;
 - name of company or individual who would own the development;
 - the local planning authority; and
 - outcome of decision.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

Next steps
