ATISN 15349 – Chemtrails spraying

Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 16 August 2021. You asked for:

Information as to what chemicals are being sprayed across Welsh skies. Specifically you asked:

1. Which law allows chemicals to be sprayed, blocking sunlight?
2. Does the Geneva Convention protect you from spraying?
3. Is the Welsh Government in breach of Nuremberg?
4. What does the spray contain?
5. Who is contracted to spray and test the chemicals sprayed?
6. Does the Welsh Government have contact with Blackrock or Vanguard?
7. How will the weather repair as hundreds of tonnes of chemical are sprayed every day?
8. What is the tipping point of chemicals per day in kilos?
9. Will the Welsh Government take responsibility for any deaths or damage to the environment (as a result of spraying)?

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is not held by the Welsh Government. Welsh Government is not aware of any such operations from aircraft spraying chemicals.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
