### **Information requested**

You asked for the following information:

- 1. What is the average cost for a service user that is 60+?**
- 2. A list of all the types of supported living and residential homes there are in Wales?**
- 3. What is the average cost per week for a service user?**

### **Our response**

#### **Average costs for a service user**

Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) does not collect or hold information in regard to the costs of placements in care services. The information is not held by any other department in the Welsh Government. Therefore, we are unable to provide any information in regards to questions 1 and 3 of your request.

### **Types of supported living and residential homes in Wales**

Supported living arrangements includes a range of locations where people hold their own tenancies and receive care and support. These individual locations are not registered with CIW as they are the residents' own homes. The agencies providing the care and support are registered with CIW as Domiciliary Support Services.

Care home services include:

- Adults care homes providing nursing care
- Adult care homes providing personal care and support
- Adult and children care homes providing nursing care
- Adult and children care homes providing personal care and support
- Childrens home
