

Free School Meals



£34m for children eligible during **school holidays**.

Food Poverty



£2m to support community food organisations.

Period Poverty



£3.3m to ensure free period products were available to all those who need them in schools, colleges and communities across Wales.

Fuel Poverty



Supported **113 lower income households** to reduce the cost of energy needed to maintain a satisfactory heating.

Benefit take-up campaign



First national benefits take up communication campaign resulted in an additional **£651,504** claimed by those entitled to benefits.

Advice services



£800,000 for advice services & frontline workers resulting in **£2.4m** claimed by those entitled to benefits.

Best Practice Toolkit



Developed a **Best Practice Toolkit** to help simplify the application system for Welsh benefits.

Pupil Deprivation Grant Access

Extended the **PDG-A grant** to eligible families in two additional school years in Primary school and



three additional years in secondary school which supported over **52,000** families across Wales.

Credit Unions



£2.5m to provide fair and affordable credit and worked based payroll savings schemes.

Public Transport



Launched the Llwybr Newydd: **a new Wales Transport Strategy**.

Single Advice Fund (SAF)



Helped over **127,000** people to deal with **286,666** social welfare problems.
