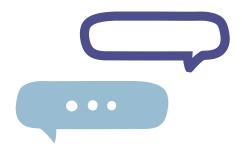


We're the Welsh Government, and we work to improve the lives of people in Wales and make our nation a better place to live and work. We're here to listen and respond to the needs of our people and communities.
