a breakdown of the number of non-disclosure agreements that have been concluded by the Welsh Government and ex-employees over the last 10 years.

the total amount paid to individuals by year.

No non-disclosure agreements have been concluded by the Welsh Government over the last 10 years (which includes our interpretation that a confidentiality clause is a clause prohibiting the individual from disclosing the circumstances under which the agreement has arisen and the basis upon which they are exiting the Welsh Government).
