

Declaration ending the Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference SO1517918422

The Chief Veterinary Officer for Wales confirmed the presence of highly pathogenic avian influenza on a premises in Wales pursuant to article 28(1) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (Wales) (No 2) Order 2006¹ (“the Order”).

In accordance with articles 28(1), 29(2) and 31(1) of the Order, the Welsh Ministers declared a Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference **SO1517918422** that took effect from 21:15 on 3 December 2021².

Pursuant to article 36(3) of the Order, the Welsh Ministers hereby end that Surveillance Zone. At least 30 days have elapsed since the completion at all infected premises in that zone of the preliminary cleansing and disinfection measures referred to in Part 2 of Schedule 3 to the Order.

This Declaration is made pursuant to articles 4 and 36(3). This Declaration takes effect from 14:10 on 10 January 2022 and amends the Declaration dated 4 January 2022 which ended the Protection Zone and restated the Surveillance Zone.

All terms in this Declaration are as defined in the Order.
