Award of Funding in relation to Road Safety Capital, Road Safety Revenue & Safe Routes in Communities Grants for Financial Year 2020/21 – Flintshire County Council

REVISED GRANT FUNDING - Road Safety Capital

This letter is in relation to revising Road Safety Capital. A revised schedule 1 is attached. The award is made under the authority of the Deputy Minister for Economy and Transport, one of the Welsh Ministers. This brings the total amount allocated to Road Safety Capital for Financial Year 2020/2021 to £631,000 (six hundred and thirty one thousand pounds).
