**EIA (Agriculture) Regulations - Consultation Request
Picton SN 009 1418**

Thank you for your EIA screening request, I have checked your map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record and other sources and there are no recorded Historic Environment Features within this consultation area. Whilst lying outside of the Registered Parkland of Picton Castle (Grade II*) it does retain an aspect of the parkland character with circular plantations of trees being a distinctive feature. It also lies within the Historic Landscape Character Area of Uzmaston and Boulston: <https://dyfedarchaeology.org.uk/HLC/milford/area/327.htm> Therefore works which are detrimental to the landscape character must be avoided.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can be provided as required.
