

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A487
(CILFAN YNG NGLANDYFI, CEREDIGION)
(CYFYNGU AR AROS) 2022**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn drwy arfer eu pwerau o dan adrannau 1(1), 2(1) a 2(2) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, sy'n dod i rym ar 22 Gorffennaf 2022.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw cyfyngu ar aros gan gerbydau ar y darn o'r gilfan ar ochr ogledd-orllewinol cefnffordd yr A487 sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 1,193 o fetrau i'r de-orllewin o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â'r C1139 sy'n arwain at Gwm Llyfnant hyd at bwynt 1,257 o fetrau i'r de-orllewin o ganolbwynt y gyffordd honno yng Nglandyfi, Ceredigion. Cyfyngir ar aros i gyfnod o 4 awr ar y mwyaf, gyda dim dychwelyd o fewn 8 awr, ar unrhyw ddiwrnod.

**THE A487 TRUNK ROAD (LAY-BY AT
GLANDYFI, CEREDIGION) (RESTRICTION
OF WAITING) ORDER 2022**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 22 July 2022.

The effect of the Order is to restrict vehicles from waiting on the length of the lay-by on the north-western side of the A487 trunk road that extends from a point 1,193 metres south-west of the centre-point of its junction with the C1139 leading to Cwm Llyfnant to a point 1,257 metres south-west of the centre-point of that junction at Glandyfi, Ceredigion. Waiting will be restricted to a maximum period of 4 hours, with no return within 8 hours, on any day.

During a period of 6 weeks from 20 July 2022, a copy of this Notice, the made Order and plan may be inspected at Machynlleth Library, Heol Maengwyn, Machynlleth SY20 8DY. The documents can also be viewed on the Welsh Government's website at <https://gov.wales/road-orders> or may be obtained free of charge by writing to Orders Branch at the address below, quoting reference number qA1487974.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds:

- a. that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or
- b. that any of the relevant requirements have not been complied with,

that person may, within 6 weeks of 19 July 2022, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
