- The letters are placed on tiles for the purpose of spacing. The tile widths and heights are given.
- 4. Dimensions are given in stroke widths (sw) 1sw is one quarter of the height of the lower case 'x'. Alphabet sizes are given in x-heights. (4sw = x-height)
- When upper case letters T, V and Y are followed are brought closer together by overlapping the upper case tile with the lower case tile by the small dimension indicated. by lower case letters a, e, g, o, r or u the letters
- When the upper case W is followed by upper case letters T, V, X, Y or Z the larger tile is used.
- See drawing WO/TH5 for lower case letters with accents.
- As a general rule when used in a block of two or more lines all tiles shall be butted together with the accent overlapping the lower portion of the tile above, as shown below.


