## **ATISN 16561 – Cladding on buildings**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 8 August 2022. You asked:

1. How many council or health board owned properties in Wales had combustible cladding used in the construction of the building?
2. How many schools were constructed using combustible cladding?
3. How many properties were constructed using aluminium composite material (ACM)?

### **Our response**

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

However, the information you are requesting on schools and council owned properties may be held by each of the 22 Local Authorities in Wales. Information on combustible cladding in Health Board properties is also not held centrally by the Welsh Government but again may be held by each individual organisation.

### **Next steps**

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
