<p>Strategic Action 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support primary schools to plan their international language provision 	<p>We will develop a Primary International Languages Toolkit to support teachers who have some, or no, knowledge of delivering language provision at primary level. The toolkit will include a resource pack and pedagogical guide on how to use the resources to support the introduction of IL in the new curriculum.</p>	<p>The French and Spanish toolkits are being translated and will be trialled and launched with primary schools in the summer term. Work is progressing well on the German toolkit.</p>
<p>Strategic Action 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase the opportunities for learners to experience languages alongside examination course 	<p>We will continue to organise enrichment activities, Pupil Language Ambassador training sessions and events for schools. For the time being, these sessions will all be delivered virtually. Our Routes into Languages Cymru Student Language Ambassadors will also engage with primary and secondary schools virtually.</p>	<p>25 students from 5 Welsh universities have been trained as Routes Cymru Language Ambassadors in October and have delivered live and pre-recorded motivational talks and sessions for secondary and primary schools in all consortia.</p> <p>The Pupil Language Ambassador Training was held on the 2nd February. 95 pupils from 18 schools took part in the training and a further 11 schools received the training video to complete asynchronously. Pre-recorded monthly activities provided by the language institutes have been shared with participating schools and the PLA Team of the Year Award will be awarded at the PLA virtual celebration ceremony in July.</p> <p>10 live webinars and two pre-recorded AS/A Level Masterclasses were delivered in February and March. Over 270 learners and teachers joined these sessions with really positive feedback. Schools can request recordings of these sessions if they missed them from our website.</p>

<p>Strategic Action 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work to reduce the marginalisation of languages 	<p>The Governors Toolkit on the Routes into Languages website will provide governing bodies and school leaders with information on how to assess the health of languages in their schools, as well as provide examples of best practice on how to support languages.</p>	<p>The Governors Toolkit is available bilingually on the Routes Cymru website Governors – llwybrau at leithoedd Cymru Routes into Languages Cymru and among the resources offered there is a ‘Good Practice Guide’ with concrete examples from schools from the 4 Regional Education Consortia on how to support Modern Languages.</p> <p>A video championing the case for language learning by Welsh businesses is currently being edited and will be available for Governing Bodies from the Routes Cymru website soon.</p>
<p>Strategic Action 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deliver a national campaign that addresses the negative perceptions of language learning. 	<p>Through the Routes into Languages Cymru Student Language Ambassador scheme, undergraduate/postgraduate students will deliver talks to primary and secondary school pupils of the benefits of language learning.</p> <p>Training Pupil Language Ambassadors (Secondary) and International Languages Superheroes (Primary) schemes will support IL departments to quash negative claims, promote positivity and raise the profile of IL on a school level.</p>	<p>Routes Cymru Student Language Ambassadors have been trained to deliver sessions for secondary and primary schools in Wales in October 2021.</p> <p>See Strategic Action 2 for information on the PLA scheme.</p>

The guidance will apply to the current 	<p>The Routes into Languages Cymru Governors Toolkit will share good practice on how languages can be prioritised and promoted in schools. The Routes Cymru Primary Toolkit will support the delivery of IL with resources and possible pedagogical approaches.</p>	<p>The Governor’s Toolkit: Good Practice Guide is freely available to be downloaded on the Routes Cymru website and shares information on how languages can be prioritised in schools giving concrete examples from schools from the 4 regional education consortia.</p> <p>The Primary Toolkit will include a ‘knowledge folder’ that will include specific information for non-IL specialist such as pronunciation guides, subject</p>
