## **ATISN 16618 – Grant to 'Climate Action Newtown CIC'**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request, which was received on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022. You requested all documentation relating to a Welsh Government grant made to Climate Action Newtown CIC group for the purposes of purchasing a property and opening a shop called 'Waste Not' at 3/4 Broad Street, Newtown, Powys, SY16 2LU.

### **Our response**

Following a search of our records, I can confirm no documentation exists in relation to a grant issued by the Welsh Government to Climate Action Newtown CIC for the purposes described in your request.

However, I can confirm that Welsh Government awarded a grant to Newtown and Llanllwchaiarn Town Council under the Circular Economy Fund for a project called "Newtown as a pioneer reuse and repair economy in Wales". The project's location was given as 3/4 Broad Street, Newtown.
