#### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 4 October 2022. You asked for:

- What support was put into place to help theatres recover?
- How the sector as a whole is recovering?

#### **Our response**

The information you requested is below.

*What support was put into place to help theatres recover?*

This information is already in the public domain. Welsh Government provided three rounds of its Cultural Recovery Fund (CRF) from the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic in March 2020 to January 2022 to support the arts sector in Wales. Support for the arts sector through the CRF programme amounted to £93m.
