

## Declaration ending the Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference SH 64750 15225.

---

The Chief Veterinary Officer for Wales confirmed the presence of highly pathogenic avian influenza on a premises in Wales pursuant to article 28(1) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (Wales) (No 2) Order 2006<sup>1</sup> (“the Order”).

In accordance with articles 28(1), 29(2) and 31(1) of the Order, the Welsh Ministers declared a Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference **SH 64750 15225** that first took effect at 18:30 on 5 September and was restated at 10:23 on 30 September 2022.

At least 30 days have elapsed since the completion at all infected premises in that zone of the preliminary cleansing and disinfection measures referred to in Part 2 of Schedule 3 to the Order. Pursuant to Article 36(3) of the Order, the Welsh Ministers hereby end that Surveillance Zone.

All terms in this Declaration are as defined in the Order.

This Declaration takes effect from 16:30 on 7 October 2022.
