**The Local Health Boards (Directed
Functions) (Wales) Directions 2022**

Made 13 December 2022

Coming into force 15 December 2022

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 12(3) and 204 of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006⁽¹⁾ give the following Directions:

Title, commencement and application

1.—(1) The title of these Directions is the Local Health Boards (Directed Functions) (Wales) Directions 2022.

(2) These Directions come into force on 15 December 2022.

(3) These Directions are given to the following Local Health Boards—

- (a) Aneurin Bevan University Local Health Board;
- (b) Betsi Cadwaladr University Local Health Board;
- (c) Cardiff and Vale University Local Health Board;
- (d) Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Local Health Board; and
- (e) Swansea Bay University Local Health Board.

Interpretation

2. In these Directions—

“relevant prisons” (“*carchardai perthnasol*”) means His Majesty’s Prison Berwyn, His


Usually resident for the purposes of regulation 2(2) of the Local Health Boards (Directed Functions) (Wales) Regulations 2009

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person who is detained in any of the relevant prisons, is, for the period of that detention, to be treated as usually resident at the address of that prison for the purpose of regulation 2(2) of the Local Health Boards (Directed Functions) (Wales) Regulations 2009(1).

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply in relation to the commissioning of psychiatric hospital care for the purposes of the removal of a person detained in prison to a hospital under section 47 or 48 of the Mental Health Act 1983(2).

Revocation

4. The Directions to Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University Local Health Board, Aneurin Bevan University Local Health Board, Betsi Cadwaladr University Local Health Board and Cardiff and Vale University Local Health Board 2017(3) are revoked.
