*Expenditure (refuse collection, incomes for govt workers, schooling, etc.) and income (through taxes, from Welsh Government, fines for overhanging hedges etc.) for the vale of Glamorgan council. In as granular detail as possible. For the past 15 years.*

The Vale of Glamorgan Council will be responsible for the information you have requested and requests for the above information would have to be submitted directly to that Council. You may wish to note that the information may be found in the Council's Statements of Accounts, which are published annually on its website. In addition the Welsh Government produces statistical information on expenditure and income by authority.
