



Capital Funding - grant and loan

£100m investment allocation in 2022-25 through the Welsh Government regeneration programme. Additional £5m Transforming Towns Loan funding allocated in 2022-23.



Town Centre First Principle

Locating services/buildings within town centres whenever possible.



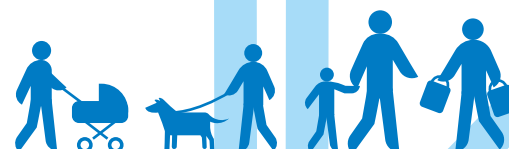
Enforcement

Robust approach to tackling empty/dilapidated properties. Supported by the provision of expert advice and a £15.2m fighting fund.



Placemaking Grant

A core allocation to local authorities which supports co-ordinated developments including residential, green infrastructure, public realm, meanwhile uses, digital and active travel.



TRANSFORMING TOWNS



Coastal Towns

£6m investment in 2021-23 through the Coastal Communities Fund, designed to support the economic development of coastal areas, promote sustainable jobs and bring regeneration to coastal town centres and high streets.



Placemaking Plans

£850k revenue funding for the development of Placemaking Plans supported by specialist advice from DCfW.



Business Improvement Districts (BIDs)

Collaborative Business and Community Models – £210k for the development of town centre business and community collaborations, including Business Improvement Districts.



Smart Towns

Programme of support for town centres and businesses to collect, interpret and exploit digital data.
