Thank you for your request which I received on 18 February 2023. You asked for the following information:

*All transactions over £25,000 from October to a month in arrears from the date at which you publish in response to this request.*

The Welsh Government has routinely published details of spend over £25,000 since April 2011. The Welsh Government aims to publish this information on a quarterly basis in arrears, subject to the availability of staff and the data having been cleared for release.

The last information was published on 8 March 2023, detailing expenditure up to November 2022. We are currently working to publish data for December 2022 to February 2023 as soon as practicable.
