Protect the environment

Check your equipment, clothing and
footwear when you leave the water.
Remove any mud, live animals or
plant material and leave it at the
site.

Clean everything thoroughly as
soon as you can, paying attention
to areas that are damp or hard to
access. Use hot water if possible.

Dry everything for as long as you
can before using elsewhere as some
invasive plants and animals can
survive for over two weeks in damp
conditions.
