WRU Loan

Steve Phillips thanked the Deputy Minister for the support the Welsh Government following the completion of £18m loan. WRU has received payment and will distribute to the regions. The Deputy Minister

Women's Game

The Deputy Minister congratulated the WRU on the award of a number of full time professional contracts to around 12 players and retained contracts to a separate group. She stated that as a 15 a side game it would have been preferable to have more full-time contracts but acknowledged that it was a positive start to a new era. The WRU agreed with this and stated it was their intention to review the numbers and hopefully increase in number going forward.

The Deputy Minister noted this was already making a difference on the pitch following the excellent away win in Dublin the previous weekend, and asked that her congratulations be passed onto the team for the win and the performance against Ireland. She also wished the team the very best for the upcoming games, including the game against Scotland at the Arms Park on Saturday (2 April).

Mixed rugby consultation

Following representations by a number of parents the WRU had decide to undertake a further consultation on its plans to reduce the age for mixed rugby. The Deputy Minister expressed her support for this and asked that they share their findings with WG, when appropriate.

Match day experience review of Six Nations

The Deputy Minister asked that following the issues encountered on match days during the Autumn Series would a similar review be carried now the Six Nations had concluded. The WRU responded that there would be but given there had been very few incidents and much better press coverage they were not expecting any adverse findings. They put this down to changes to selling alcohol, and agreed to discuss any issues with officials.
