The amount paid to City to Sea following analysis of the claims was £236,611.13

We do not hold the Welsh Government staff costs as we didn't have specific fulltime equivalents assigned to the work to enable me to calculate it.

We do not hold details of the costs of the physical refill taps as these were not directly paid for through the Welsh Government grant.
