Dear Colleague

The purpose of this circular is to ensure that all GPs in Wales and all Local Health Boards in Wales are aware of and consider:

 The National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) guidance on <u>Overview | Self-harm: assessment, management and preventing</u> <u>recurrence | Guidance | NICE</u>

The guidance covers assessment, management and preventing recurrence for children, young people and adults who have self-harmed. It includes those with a mental health problem, neurodevelopment disorder or learning disability and applies to all sectors that work with people who have self-harmed.

The guidance includes recommendations on:

- Information and support
- Consent and confidentiality
- Safeguarding
- Involving family members and carers
- Psychosocial assessment and care by mental health professionals
- Risk assessment tools and scales
- Assessment and care by healthcare professionals and social care practitioners
- Assessment and care by professionals and from other sectors
- Admission to and discharge from hospital
- Initial aftercare after an episode of self-harm
- Interventions for self-harm
- Supporting people to be safe after self-harm
- Safer prescribing and dispensing
- Training and supervision
