THE TRUNK ROAD (A487) (NEWPORT, DYFED) (DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 1987

MADE 23rd September 1987
COMING INTO FORCE 28th October 1987

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Constabulary hereby orders and directs as follows:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 28th October 1987 and may be cited as the Trunk Road (A487) (Newport, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1987.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Act of 1984.

SCHEDULE

That length of the Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road (A487) situated at Newport in the County of Dyfed extending from a point 40 metres east of the junction of the trunk road with the unclassified Ffordd Bedd Morris to a point 55 metres west of the said junction, a distance of 95 metres.
