## Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 19 April 2023. You asked for:

- 1. A breakdown of the total cost, including that of public consultations, relating to Bannau Brycheiniog National Park Authority's (formerly Brecon Beacons National Park Authority) adoption of the Welsh name 'Bannau Brycheiniog' in English contexts.
- 2. An indication of the time spent by Welsh Government officials on the move to using the Welsh name in English contexts, and a breakdown of the costs incurred by Welsh Government on that move.

## Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require in relation to your first question is not held by the Welsh Government. In terms of your second question, no time or money was spent by Welsh Government and its officials on the adoption of 'Bannau Brycheiniog' in English contexts.
