Thank you for your request which I received on 20 April 2023. You asked for:

- The number of licence applications the Welsh Government has received in regard of protected species on a proposed site for an intensive poultry farm with over 40,000 birds present.
- How many licences were granted, which allowed the proposed works to be carried out?
- Copies of the applications, including relevant attachments, approval letters or documents sent to the applicant.
