Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 17 May 2023. You asked :

- What maintenance contracts does the Welsh Government have for its vehicles based outside of Cardiff.

Our response

We hold no information about any current maintenance contracts outside of Cardiff.

Marine and Fisheries have 21 4x4 vehicles that are located around the coast of Wales. When bought new from Mitsubishi UK, included in the purchase was a five-year maintenance contract which was serviced through a number of Mitsubishi Main Dealers. This service contract has expired this year, at the end of the five-year period. We are continuing to have the vehicles serviced through a number of the remaining Mitsubishi dealerships, but there is no maintenance contract in place. All vehicles are being maintained in line with the Mitsubishi service schedule using genuine Mitsubishi parts and recommended lubricants etc.

Additionally WG Transport own and manage two pool 4x4 vehicles, one Mitsubishi outlander based in Coryton and serviced by the dealer in Bridgend and we have one Land Rover Freelander based in Llandudno Junction and serviced locally by a garage in Conwy.

Cadw operate 10 vans of Cardiff, being welfare and goods vans split between 4 regional teams, but again there are no maintenance contracts on these.

Next steps
