Thank you for your request which was received on 3 July 2023. You asked for the following information:

*Does the Welsh Government have any non-disclosure agreements with another party? If so, provide a breakdown of when the NDAs were issued by year.*

I wrote to you on 6 July to request clarification on the information that you were seeking but I received no response. This response is therefore based on NDAs with current or former employees of Welsh Government (only). Our policy is that the Welsh Government does not use NDAs – there are none in place.
