Thank you for your request for information which I received on 27 June.

## Your request

You asked for the following information regarding North Wales Rail Services:

1. I note TfW Rail state on their website that all Class 175 s are available for traffic. Why are they being left in sidings and not put into service to provide adequate space for passengers? I used the trains from Warrington Bank Quay - Chester, Chester to Rhyl, Prestatyn to Shotton \& Shotton to Shrewsbury over the period 18-19 June 2023 and there was insufficient seats or luggage space on the two car 197s, 156 \& 158 units.
2. Why are TfW tickets not valid on Avanti trains from Chester to Rhyl?
