Thank you for your request which was received on 29 June 2023. You asked for the following information:

1. What methods do you use to gather the IP addresses for anyone who communicates with Welsh Government?

We do not use any methods to actively gather IP addresses of those who communicate with us. Such information may be held by nature of the transmission (for example, IP addresses of email servers are routinely captured by the email system) and are programmatically analysed by our service providers in order to prevent spam, detect phishing, etc. but we do not collate or analyse this information for any other purpose.

2. Provide the numbers of collected IP addresses over the past 5 years?

This information is not held.

3. Of the IP addresses that have been gathered how many have subsequently been blocked?

This information is not held.

4. What is the prime purpose of collating IP addresses?

5. On how many occasions in the past five years has any Member of the Senedd asked for an IP address to be blocked?
