ATISN 18798 – Brilliant Basics Funding

Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 03 August 2023. You asked for:

In relation to the Welsh Government's £5 million Brilliant Basics Fund 2023/24, please state:

1. How much money Conwy County Borough Council applied for;
2. What Conwy County Borough Council applied for financial assistance to go towards;
3. The maximum amount of money a single local authority could apply for.

Our response

1. Local authorities were asked to prioritise two project submissions at a maximum grant value of £300,000 per project. Conwy County Borough Council originally submitted five expressions of interest. They then prioritised two projects for application and the total amount of funding requested for these was £433,200.
2. Conwy County Borough Council applied for financial assistance to go towards:
 - Llandudno shelters and colonnades – replacing three shelters along Llandudno's North Shore Promenade and resurfacing of walls and floors and installation of new benches at Llandudno Colonnades.
Grant awarded £300,000.
 - Destination and directional signage across Conwy County.
Grant awarded £133,200.
3. The maximum grant a single local authority could receive was £600,000.
