

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A465 (Y
GILFAN TUA'R GORLLEWIN YN LLAN-
FFWYST, Y FENNI, SIR FYNWY) (GWAHARD
CERBYDAU DROS DRO)**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn caniatáu i lwythi anwahanadwy annormal (fel y diffinnir “abnormal indivisible loads” yng Ngorchymyn Cerbydau Ffyrrd (Awdurdodi Mathau Arbennig) (Cyffredinol) 2003 (y cyfeirir ato yma wedi hyn fel “Gorchymyn 2003”)) gael eu cludo’n ddiogel ar gefnffordd yr A465 yn Llan-ffwyst, y Fenni, Sir Fynwy.

Effaith y Gorchymyn fydd gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd (ac eithrio'r rheini sy'n teithio gyda'r llwythi anwahanadwy annormal wrth iddynt symud a'r rheini sy'n cael eu defnyddio gan y gwasanaethau brys) rhag mynd ar y darn o gilfan cerbytffordd tua'r gorllewin cefnffordd yr A465 sy'n dechrau o bwynt 156 o fetrau i'r gorllewin o ffordd ymuno tua'r gorllewin yr A465/B4246 wrth Gyfnewidfa Llan-ffwyst, y Fenni.

Bydd y gilfan ar gau rhwng 06:00 o'r gloch ar 19 Awst 2023 a 23:59 o'r gloch ar 20 Awst 2023; rhwng 06:00 o'r gloch ar 26 Awst 2023 a 23:59 o'r gloch ar 27 Awst 2023; a rhwng 06:00 o'r gloch ar 2 Medi 2023 a 23:59 o'r gloch ar 3 Medi 2023 neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod yr amseroedd a'r dyddiadau a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 6 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad ymlaen llaw am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A465 TRUNK ROAD (WESTBOUND
LAYBY AT LLANFOIST, ABERGAVENNY,
MONMOUTHSHIRE) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER
2023**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to permit the safe transportation of abnormal indivisible loads (AIL) (as defined in the Road Vehicle (Authorisation of Special Types) (General) Order 2003 (hereinafter referred to as “the 2003 Order”)) on the A465 trunk road at Llanfoist, Abergavenny Monmouthshire.

The effect of the Order will be to temporarily prohibit all vehicles (other than those which are accompanying the AIL movement and being used by the emergency services) from entering the length of the A465 trunk road westbound carriageway layby that commences 156 metres west of the A465/ B4246 westbound entry slip road at Llanfoist Interchange, Abergavenny.

The layby closure will operate from 06:00 hours on 19 August 2023 until 23:59 hours on 20 August 2023; from 06:00 hours on 26 August 2023 until 23:59 hours on 27 August 2023; and from 06:00 hours on 2 September 2023 until 23:59 hours on 3 September 2023 or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the times and dates specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 6 months as a contingency should the closure need to be rescheduled or consequential or other closure is required. Advance notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled closure.
