The Primary Care (Contracted Services: Immunisations) (Amendment) Directions 2023

Made 23 August 2023

Coming into force 25 August 2023

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 10, 12(3) and 203(9) and (10) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006(1), make the following Directions.

Title, application and commencement

- **1.**—(1) The title of these Directions is the Primary Care (Contracted Services: Immunisations) (Amendment) Directions 2023.
 - (2) These Directions are given to Local Health Boards.
 - (3) These Directions come into force on 25 August 2023.

Amendment of the Primary Care (Contracted Services: Immunisations) Directions 2021

- **2.**—(1) The Primary Care (Contracted Services: Immunisations) Directions 2021(2) are amended as follows.
- (2) In Direction 4 (Primary Care Contracted Services: Immunisations Scheme) for paragraph (4)(e) substitute—
 - "(e) payment arrangements for an engaged provider which must provide for it to be able to claim, in accordance with paragraph 7 of the Covid-19 Vaccines Specification, a payment of £10.03.".
- (3) In Schedule 1 (Primary Care Contracted Services: Immunisations (Covid-19 Vaccines) Specification) for paragraph 7(a) (Payment for administration of a Covid-19 vaccine under this PCCS:I) substitute—
 - "(a) The Local Health Board must pay to an engaged provider who qualifies for the payment in accordance with Directions 5 to 7, a payment of £10.03 in respect of each dose of a Covid-19 vaccine administered to a person under this PCCS:I.".
