- 4. A list of the top 10 ministers for the amount of money spent on ministerial car journeys made in this period.
- 5. A copy of any internal memos or emails sent to ministers since July 2022 discouraging the use of ministerial cars or warning against increased scrutiny of ministerial car use.

The information you have requested is shown below:

- 1. The number of times ministerial cars have been used by Welsh Government ministers from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023 is 1,873.
- 2. The total cost of all these journeys (including driver pay, petrol and other costs) was £490.484.
