## **Request for Information – ATISN 18829**

Thank you for your request for information dated 10 August.

### **Information requested**

How many meetings has the Welsh Government, Welsh Government officials or representatives and Transport for Wales had with each individual police force in Wales in relation to the 20mph speed limit change?

### **Our response**

No meetings were held with individual police forces, as engagement has been through meetings at which more than one force was represented, and/or via the police liaison officer who is part of the project team dedicated to 20mph delivery and reports to Roads Policing for Wales. The police liaison officer also provides a link to the senior police officers in all four police forces.

### **Next steps**
