## Information requested.

Thank you for your request which I received on 24 August 2023. You asked for:

The total cost of replacement of buses on the T1 and T2 routes with new electric ones in 2023, as well as associated replacement bus shelters.

## Our response

- Welsh Government has provided Carmarthenshire County Council with capital grant funding of £3.70m to purchase electric buses for use on the TrawsCymru T1 route linking Aberystwyth to Carmarthen in financial year 2021/22 and 2022/23. No funding has been provided to date for vehicles for use on the TrawsCymru T2 route.
- Welsh Government has provided Ceredigion County Council with capital grant funding of £4.320m and Gwynedd Council capital grant funding of £1.085m to improve bus stops and passenger waiting facilities on TrawsCymru bus routes T1, T2, T3 and T5 in financial years 2019/21, 2021/22, 2022/23 and 2023/24.
