ATISN 18998 - Speed limit

Thank you for your request which was received on 17 September 2023. You asked for the following information:

• Number of deaths on all Welsh 30mph roads that were caused solely by a driver travelling at 30mph, for the past 6 years.

Not to include, drink or drug driving, people on mobile phones, not travelling at any speed above 30mph, not medical issue related or anything other than traveling at 30mph which the driver of the car caused the RTA.

Our response

The data that we collect from police forces on police recorded road accidents does not include the speed at which a vehicle was travelling. Therefore, we do not hold any data on the number of deaths that were caused solely by a driver travelling at 30mph.

We do hold data on the contributory factors (CFs) that are recorded by police officers. CFs in road collisions are the key actions and failures that led directly to the collision. They show the opinion of attending police officers for why collisions occurred. A full list of CFs are published within the STATS19 form, and can be found on page 4. A summary of CFs for killed or seriously injured (KSI) collisions is published in our annual release.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
