Thank you for your request which I received on 20 September 2023. You asked for:

With respect to the 20mph speed limit introduced.

- 1) What is the amount of extra pollution expected to be created by its introduction over the next 5 years.
- 2) How much pollution was caused by the previous speed limits.
- 3) How much does vehicle pollution contribute to overall pollution levels in Wales.
- 4) How many additional deaths are expected as a result of the 20mph limit introduction from pollutants.
- 5) What increase is expected to respiratory, chest, etc. conditions from pollutants.
- 6) what increased cost to the NHS will arise from conditions arising from pollution from the 20mph speed limit.
