

ATISN 19155: Judicial Reviews against the Welsh Government in Relation to Planning Matters at Wrexham County Borough Council

Thank you for your request which I received on 11 October 2023. You asked for:

Under the FOI legislation I would like to obtain details of any judicial reviews that have been filed against the Welsh government in relation to planning matters in Wrexham.

Specifically, I would request details of any completed or withdrawn judicial reviews in relation to the Wrexham local development plan.

I would like the details of the judicial review, i.e. who submitted it, the outcome and if costs were claimed by the Welsh government and the amount if available

In response to your request, I can provide the following information:

- A judicial review was issued against the Welsh Ministers in the Cardiff Administrative (Planning) Court in the name of Wrexham CBC on 17 August 2023.
- The claim was subsequently discontinued by the claimant on 26 September 2023.
- To the extent that documents relating to the claim are in the public domain, the applicant can apply to the Cardiff Administrative (Planning) Court for them. The claim no is AC-2023-CDF-000006.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
