## **ATISN 19251**

Thank you for your request which was received on 6 November 2023. You asked for the following information:

Copies of correspondence and evidence in relation to the following questions:

- 1. What checks and balances are in place to ensure factual scripting in videos commissioned or produced inhouse by Welsh Government? How is this approved by the department that commissioned the piece of work?
- 2. What is the procedure when inviting external organisations to be part of a film produced in house by Welsh Government, for checking that the content is factually correct and how is the content approved?

All content published on our Welsh Government social media channels is checked by Welsh Government policy officials prior to publication for factual accuracy. You have requested information that involves different teams and different departments across the Welsh Government. At an estimate of taking 30 seconds to search and collate each individual approval, it would take in excess of 24 hours. Because this exceeds the appropriate limit established in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate limit and Fees) Regulations 2004, I have decided not to process that part of your request.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
