Thank you for your request which I received on 2 January 2024. You asked:

 How much funding the Welsh Government gives to the Welsh Refugee council per year?

Our response

The Welsh Government does not allocate annual recurrent funding to the Welsh Refugee Council. However, the Welsh Refugee Council receives funding for specific purposes via procured contracts or awards of grant funding.

For the financial year 2023-24, the Welsh Government has awarded the Welsh Refugee Council £171,364.90 in grant funding, via the Homelessness Prevention Grant. The Welsh Refugee Council has also received funding as part of a consortium delivering the Welsh Government's commissioned Wales Sanctuary Service. The consortium is led by Welsh Refugee Council but also includes five other third sector organisations. The value of the original contract was £1.08m (excluding VAT), to deliver the service between April 2022 and March 2025.

In response to the Ukraine crisis and support needs of those arriving in Wales, the Wales Sanctuary Service overall contract value was increased to £1.62m (exc VAT). How funds are distributed within the consortium is a matter for consortium members.
