- 1. The total number of fines, penalty points, and speed awareness courses issued during the 20 mph speed limit trialled in St Brides Major before the limit came in to law.
- 2. What speed limit was applied to result in enforcement action being taken.
- 3. What other enforcement methods such as warnings or training videos were issued during that trial period.
