# Moving on from your Welcome Centre, hotel or holiday park

## Information for Ukrainians with pets

**You will be supported to move into a longer-term home as all initial accommodation will be closed this year.**

**You must work with your local authority to help them find you the best available pet-friendly home to rent or home with a host.**

- Please be aware demand for housing is high, especially in cities. Finding pet friendly accommodation is even more challenging. You should accept your first offer if you can.
- It may be helpful to provide information about your pet such as details on their breed, size, behaviour and vaccination records.
- Consider offering to introduce your pet to a potential landlord.
- Your new home will meet the housing needs of your family including your pet. It may be in a different area, but all services will be accessible.
- Never try to keep a pet in a property without the landlord's consent. This could lead to your tenancy being terminated.
- Living in pet friendly accommodation will be more affordable for you. The cost of kennels and catteries is high and you also may have limited contact with your pet.
